# Preparation Considerations

---

## Temperatures

- Day time expect mid 70's to possible low 80's for pre trip. Mid 80's in Lisbon
- Evening expect mid 60's



## Visiting Churches

SHORTS ARE FINE (NOT SUPER SHORT)  
T-SHIRTS ARE FINE (NO TANK TOPS/CROP TOPS)

## Lots of Walking

- Plan on walking up to 5-10+ miles a day!!!
  - Start walking now
- Comfortable Shoes!!! 2 PAIRS IF POSSIBLE
  - Make sure you break them in before you go



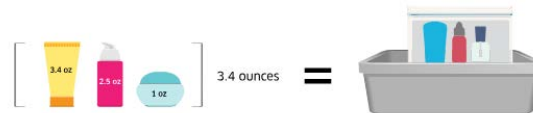
# PACKING FOR WYD

## LUGGAGE CONSIDERATIONS

- Allowed 1 bag to check in
  - Weight limit of 50 lbs
- 1 carry on bag (a good day pack)
  - Main bag
  - Need to carry stuff to vigil
- Place to carry sleeping bag
  - You will need to lug it around - ideally pack it in checked bag

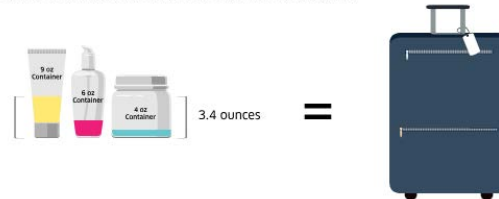
### Carry-On Bag

3.4 ounces (100 ml) or smaller sized containers that fit in 1 quart-sized, resealable bag may go in carry-on and through checkpoint security.



### Checked Bag

Containers that are larger than 3.4 ounces (100ml) regardless of amount inside must be in checked baggage.



### One checked bag allowed

- 50lbs Maximum weight for checked bags
- 62in Maximum size for checked bags: height + length+ width



### One carry-on bag allowed

- 22lbs Maximum weight for carry-on bag
- 22x16x8in Maximum dimensions of height x length x width



### One small personal item also allowed (handbag, purse, moneybelt)

- 4.4lbs Maximum weight of a personal item
- 16x12x5in Maximum dimensions of height x length x width

Keep large dollars in money belt

\*Keep passport in belt or passport holder (I prefer passport holder)

Credit cards

Keep under your garments

France , Spain and Portugal – Euros

Exchange rate :

- \$1 US is equal to .92 Euro (*currently*)

How much to bring?

- Most recommended amounts are \$300-\$500
- Exchange at US at bank in advance
- ATM's are common and best, even though there is a fee. Need debit card. Check with your bank.

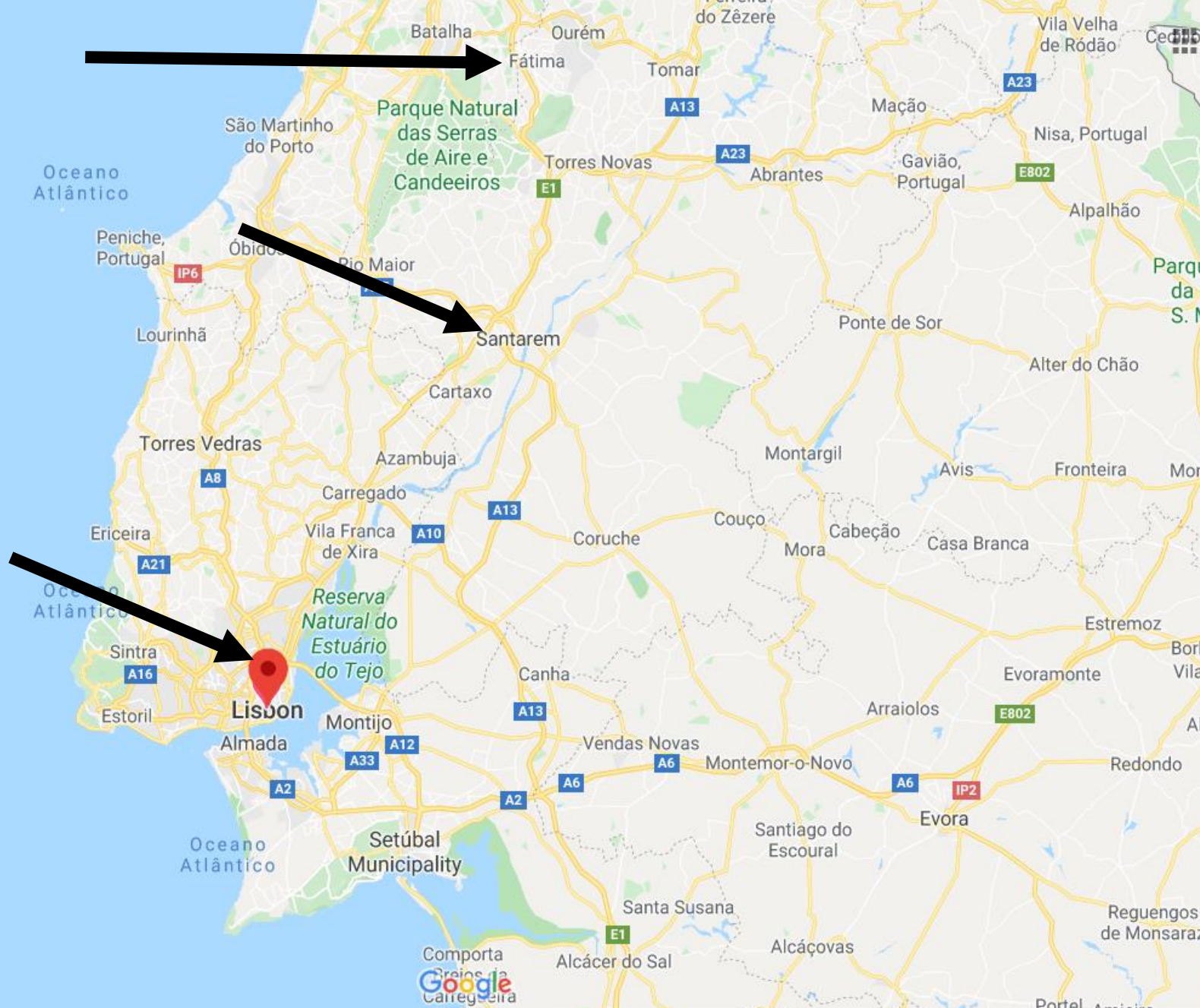

# Lisbon Location

SUNDAY NIGHT IN FATIMA.**





A woman living in Santarém, Portugal in the 13th was distressed that her husband was unfaithful to her, and she decided to consult a sorceress for help. The sorceress told her the price of her services was a consecrated host.

She went to Mass at the Church of St. Stephen and received the Eucharist on her tongue, removed the Eucharist from her mouth, wrapped it in her veil, and headed to the door of the church. But before she got out, the host began to bleed.

When she got home, she put the bloodied host in a trunk. That night, a miraculous light emanated from the trunk. She repented of what she had done and the next morning confessed to her priest. Her priest came and retrieved the host and took it back to the church.





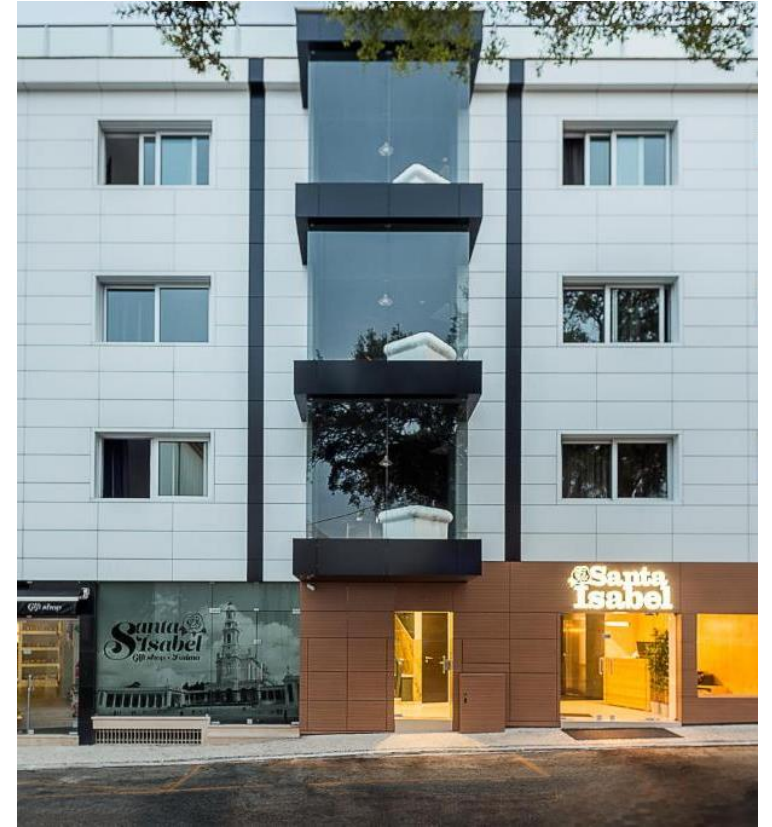

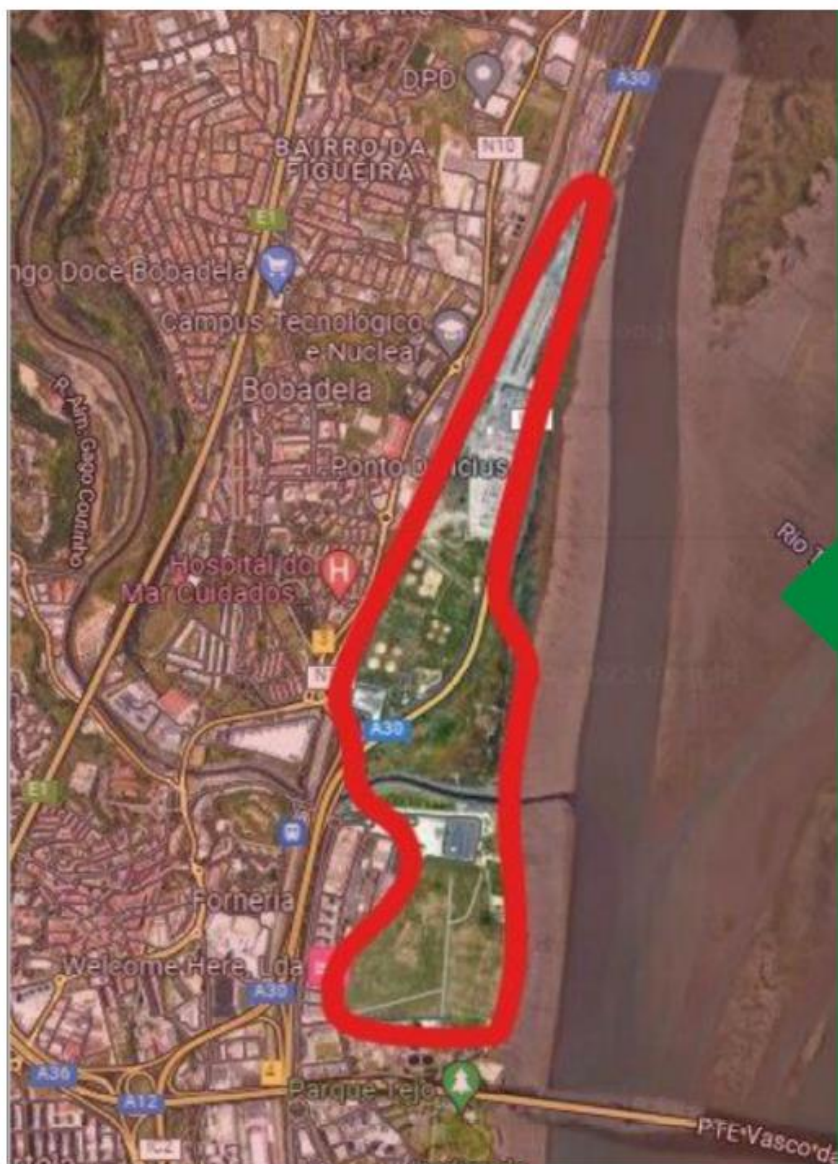


# Walk to Vigil
